We presented a paper on the use of precision data to refine soil norms for wheat production in the Mkushi area of Zambia. The data was collected from the Silverlands farm in Kakushi. They have been our customer for 4 years and we now have developed a system whereby we use their own yield data to fine tune the fertilizer program. We would like to achieve this in a similar way with our tobacco customers using our unique approach in the AglO software.
